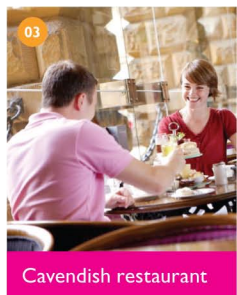
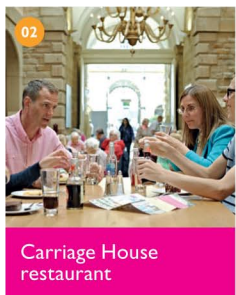
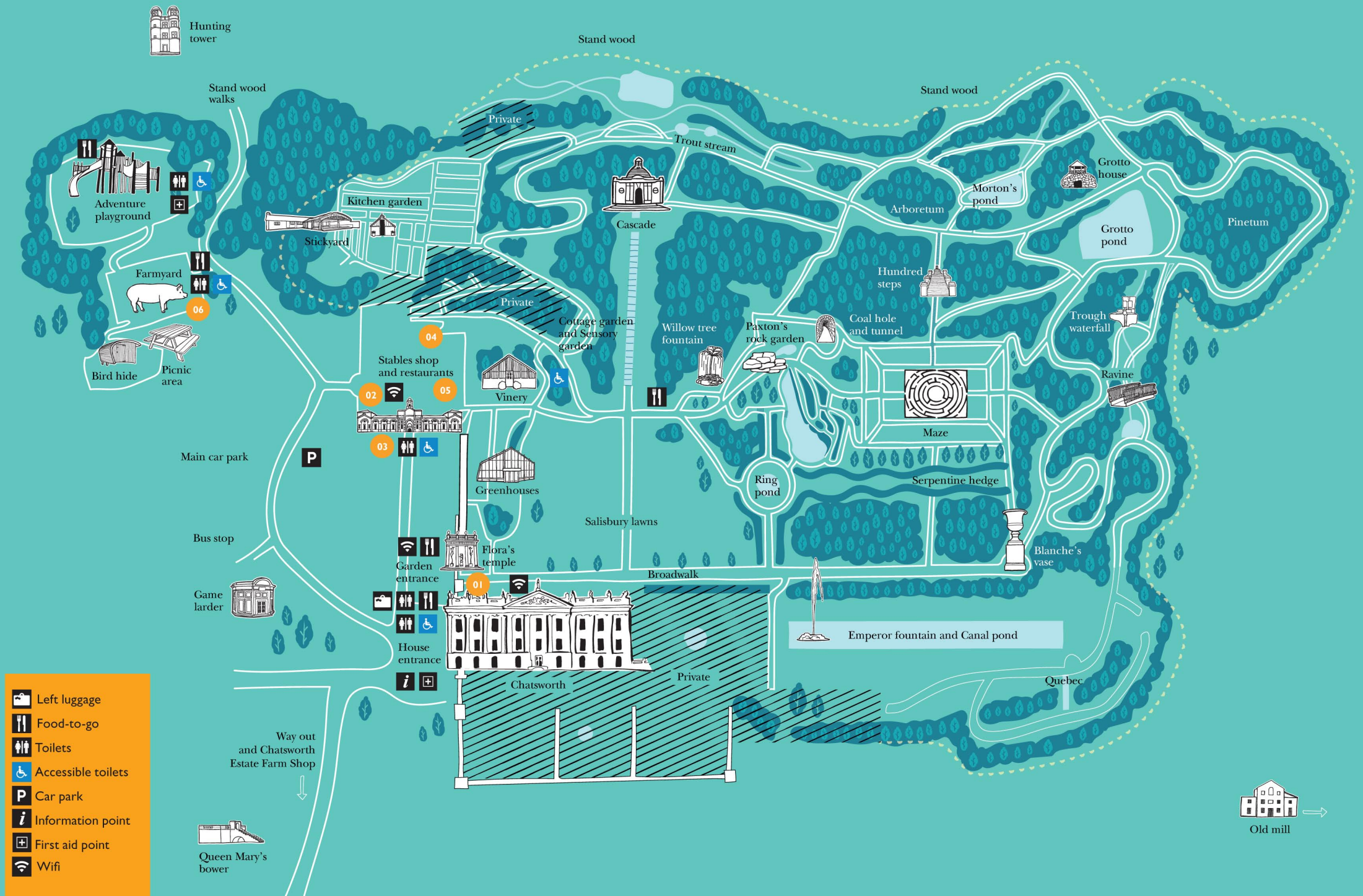


Let us show you around



PLEASE NOTE

- In drier periods, playing of the gravity-fed waterworks is restricted.
- Garden paths around our main visitor facilities are wide and flat. Paths in more remote areas may be uneven and the terrain more rugged. Natural hazards will be present such as steep slopes, lakes, ponds and rock formations. Please keep children supervised.

- Please refer to the garden accessibility map (available from ticket offices) for those paths and areas not accessible with pushchairs, wheelchairs or mobility scooters.
- The Cascade was not originally constructed for walking in. The stones can become slippery. Please keep children supervised near the Cascade.
- Personal, non-commercial photography is welcome.
- The car parks close at 7pm.
- The use of drones is prohibited.

- Please keep children supervised, especially near lakes and ponds.
- Dogs are welcome in the garden and park but must be kept on a lead at all times.
- House wifi is in the North entrance hall only.
- Food-to-go outlets may close in extreme weather conditions.
- The Stickyard is open to visitors during bank holidays.
- There are tractors and other vehicle movements within the garden at all times. Please take care.
