### **TWO PHASE COMPETITION**

#### FIRST PHASE – SHOW JUMPING

Speed 325mpm with time allowed	
Approx. 9 fences	
First refusal	5 penalties
Second refusal	10 penalties
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination
Exceeding time allowed	Elimination

#### SECOND PHASE – CROSS COUNTRY

Speed 400mpm with a 10 second	nd time window
Approx. 9 fences	
First refusal	20 penalties
Second refusal	40 penalties
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination

There will be an optimum time for the Cross Country phase with a 10 second window

Any time slower than the optimum = 1 penalty per second

Any time more than 10 seconds faster than the optimum = 1 penalty per second

Time penalties will not be incurred within the 10 second window. The ranking will be decided on a) total score then

b) closest to the optimum time.

Chatsworth International Horse Trials Arena Eventing competitions are now a qualifier for the Konsileo Insurance National Arena Eventing with ROR Championships, taking place at Eland Lodge on 26th & 27th August 2023. This is a new, exciting, National Arena Eventing Championships, including the RoR Arena Eventing National Championships and is open to everyone. BE and BS points limits apply.

Top 10 will qualify from each class.

Qualified competitors contact details will be passed to Katharine Martin in order to make contact after Chatsworth. Anyone not consenting to this must notify the Chatsworth Entries Secretary prior to the event.

- Entries close: 16 April 2023. If we receive more than 160 entries per day a waitlist of no more than 25 per day will be held. The waitlists will be displayed on <u>www.eventingscores.co.uk</u> and will be updated regularly.
- Refunds: Entries withdrawn on or before 5 May (or if the event is cancelled by that date) will be refunded less the booking fee and a £5 admin fee. Entries withdrawn after that date will not be refunded unless replaced from the waitlist when a full refund less a £5 admin fee will be made. We have adverse weather insurance so if the event is cancelled or abandoned for that reason all entries will be refunded as above.

**Equine Influenza:** No horse/pony may take part unless it has a current vaccination against equine influenza which complies with the following conditions: Two injections for primary vaccination not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart. A first Booster injection must be given within 7 months (not more than 215 days) after the 2nd injection of primary vaccination. Subsequent booster injection must be given at intervals of not more than one year commencing after the first booster injection. In order to compete a horse/pony must also have had a vaccination within 6 calendar months and 21 days of the competition but no injection should have been given 7 days before the competition
