We offer complimentary tickets to accompanying teachers in line with the national teacher–pupil ratio guidelines. All additional teachers or lecturers are charged at the standard pupil rate. Pupil ratios are devised by the UK Department for Education. To validate your risk assessments and to comply with Chatsworth's safeguarding policy, group visits should adhere to the ratios set for each key stage.

Foundation stage, key stages 1 and 2 – ratio 1:6

Key stages 3 and 4 – ratio 1:10

Key stage 5 and above – ratio 1:10

Paying for visits

1. Upon receipt of your booking form arrangements will be made for your group and a confirmation email will be sent to you
2. Payment can be on arrival by cash, card or cheque (payable to Chatsworth House Trust) or invoice. For invoicing, the amount must be greater than £100.
3. The management reserve the right to alter admission prices without prior notice

House and Garden

1. All groups will be given a timed entry for the house. With larger parties, we may split your group into different entry times
2. Visitors are allowed to take small bags into the House. However, we recommend that larger bags, rucksacks and lunchboxes are left on the coach or stored in our secure lockers near the North Gate. Please ask a member of the visitor experience team to assist you

Farmyard

1. All Farmyard sessions are an additional £2.00 per person and on the day will include animal feed for each pupil. We will also provide an indoor space for lunch for groups with a session.
2. Please be aware that we are only able to offer animal handling experiences as part of pre-arranged add on sessions. Public chick handling sessions are not part of your education booking
3. Self-guided visits in the farmyard do not include a reserved space for lunch however there are a number of undercover options available.
4. The tractor trailer has lap belts, a ramp and wheelchair clamping facility
