

Chatsworth Country Fair Sustainability Statement

At Chatsworth we are committed to enhancing our environment and we strive to reduce our impact on it. This requires a process of continuous improvement, and the Chatsworth Country Fair has made strong progress to date.

Waste Collection

Waste from across the site is gathered in by the 1st Tupton Scout Group teams. It is then removed from site by Peak Waste.

Peak Waste are a local waste recycling company who have a 'zero landfill' policy. The waste they remove from site is sorted, then either recycled, reused, or baled and sent to a waste energy plant where it is used as fuel to generate electricity.

Catering

All catering outlets at the event have been tasked with working towards using only environmentally friendly and reusable products, avoiding single use plastics and introducing items made from recycled materials.

Vehicles

We are using an increasing number of electric vehicles on site in the build phase, on event days and for site clearance post-event.

Vehicle movement is strictly limited during the event, both for safety purposes and to minimise emissions.

We encourage all those attending the event to turn off car engines, if they are held in traffic at any point during the visit.

Refillable Water Bottles

Taps supplying drinking water are situated across the site. We encourage all those attending the event to bring refillable water bottles to minimise single use plastics.
