





#### CARRIAGE HOUSE

The Carriage House is set within our Grade I listed Stables, designed in 1758 by James Paine. With original stone walls and archways, it is an architecturally significant and atmospheric setting for a memorable wedding.



To the side is a conservatory with a bar and courtyard. This private reception space provides your guests with direct access to our 105-acre garden, a spectacular backdrop for photographs.

Our Cavendish Suite, in the 18<sup>th</sup> century Stables, comprises the elegant Cavendish Restaurant and the Hartington and Burlington Rooms. Intimate and inviting, they're the perfect combination of spaces for an allinclusive winter wedding.

The ceremony will take place in the Hartington Room. The bridal bouquet, buttonholes and a floral room display will be provided by our onsite floristry team.

Your guests can enjoy prosecco and canapés while our photographer shares the best locations in the parkland to capture your official wedding photographs.

A three-course wedding breakfast will be served in the Burlington Room, prepared by our chefs using seasonal produce sourced from trusted local makers and paired with our house wine. After a prosecco toast, your party will continue in the Cavendish Restaurant with our resident DJ. A light evening buffet will be served.

You'll have the support of a wedding coordinator throughout the planning and staging of your wedding, and the Chatsworth event team will help ensure the day runs smoothly.

The Carriage House must be left clean and tidy with all decorations and external equipment removed on the night of the event. Make a grand entrance from Lodge Hill through the Stables courtyard. The surrounding parkland provides a spectacular backdrop for photography.

Once approved by our team, your caterer will enjoy full access to our professional Carriage House kitchen. The space can comfortably accommodate up to 130 guests at 6ft round tables with up to 10 seated at each table. A dedicated event supervisor will liaise with your suppliers on the day.






## FLOWERS
